

# by Martin McDonagh

Martin McDonagh's plays are highly crafted works with brilliantly drawn characters that audiences really care about. "Hangmen" is dark, very funny and deliniously horrendous. There are twists and turns that you won't see coming and lots of subtle observations on relationships and life.

#### He says: -

"I suppose I walk that line between comedy and cruelty because I think one illuminates the other. We're all cruel, aren't we? We are all extreme in one way or another at times and that's what drama, since the Graeks, has dealt with. I hope the overall view isn't just that though, or I've failed in my writing. There have to be moments when you glimpse something decent, something lifeaffirming even in the most twisted character. That's where the real art lies."

I first became enthralled with McDonagh's writing when directing "The Beauty Queen of Leenane" sixteen years ago so am thrilled to have the opportunity to direct this multi-award winning play. "Hangmen" was always going to be an extremely challenging production and I have been fortunate to have assembled a talented cast including several actors new to NVT together with an amazing design team and superb production support. Originally scheduled for July 2020 and after recasting several roles I am delighted that we are, at last, able to include this stunning play in our current Season.

In his small pub in Oldham, Harry is something of a local celebrity. But what's the second-best hangman in England to do on the day they've abolished hanging? Amongst the cub reporters and sycophantic pub regulars, dying to hear Harry's reaction to the news, his old assistant Syd and the peculiar Mooney lurk with very different motives for their visit.


#### Jason Lever - Bill



# Laura Scobie - Shirley





# Cock by Mike Bartlett directed by Richard Lindfield

13th - 21st May 2022 In the Studio Theatre

Boy meets girl but boy is already living with boy. Mike Bartlett's 'Cock' is a sharp, witty study of a man torn between his long-time male partner and his new lover, who just happens to be a woman. When John takes a break from his boyfriend, he accidentally meets the girl of his dreams on his daily commute. Filled with guilt and indecision, he struggles to find a way to square the eternal triangle. 'Cock' explores the age-old themes of love and longing and asks questions about who we are and who we want to be.

Bartlett wrote the play while living in Mexico, where cock-fighting is very much alive and pecking. 'Cock' isn't just a reference to the male member but also to characters taking chunks out of each other in a fight to the death.

This production contains strong language and has adult themes.

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#### Renewal at New Venture - Year Two of our 5 Year Plan

Hopefully you are aware that we are trying to raise money to carry out some important renovations and improvements to our wonderful Grade It listed theatre. Although recent relaxations in the COVID rules mean we can now put on shows again, the pandemic has already reduced our anticipated income for 2021/22. Additionally we have recently discovered significant repairs are needed to the large windows on south side of the building. The need to raise funds is therefore even more important as the Committee


